Allergies

At Turrill we have a wide variety of students with allergies ranging from peanut, tree nut, walnuts, citrus, bee stings, eggs, and many more. Each classroom that has students with various allergies will receive letters informing families of the allergies and what to avoid when sending treats, snacks, and lunches to school. With these letters, we also have designated various areas of our school to be nut free. These nut free areas can be found in some classrooms, certain tables in the lunch room, as well as entire grade levels. Turrill staff, families and students appreciate all that you do to help keep our students safe and following through with the various unique situations and requirements with our students.

▪ End of the Year Assembly Celebration

On June 12th we will be having our end of the year assembly and celebrations. During this event, students will be recognized for all of their hard work as they enter into another grade. Individual classrooms may also have additional awards after the assembly and information will go home in newsletters or other forms of communication. ▪ Student Transition

On Friday June 13th we will have our students transition into their new grade levels. This student transition meeting is an opportunity for students to transition into their next year's classroom and spend time getting to know their teacher for the next year. This opportunity also allows for students to spend time becoming comfortable with their new classroom and classmates prior to leaving for the summer. Prior to this student transition opportunity, all families will receive their student placement letters. This student transition is a student activity; parents will have a chance to also meet their child's new teacher at our welcome back night in July.

On June 13th at the end of the day we will have a clap out for our fifth grade students as they leave Turrill one last time prior to becoming middle school student. Each classroom will line up outside of their classroom and clap while the fifth grade students walk the halls and then exit the building one last time. 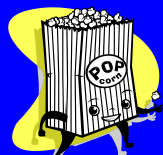
