Dear Turrill Students and Families,

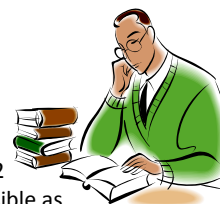

Now that the 2011-2012 school year has ended, I wanted to give each of you as much information as possible as we move closer to the start of the 2012/2013 school year and the opening of Turrill Elementary. In this newsletter you will find staffing information, upcoming events, as well as other information. Please know that as the summer progresses I will be keeping all of you updated. The opening of Turrill as a year-round school will be an event that many Lapeer Community District employees and the greater Lapeer Community are very excited about and I'm thrilled to begin this experience with your family.

The journey has already begun for Turrill and there will be a great deal involved in the continued preparation for August 1<sup>st</sup> 2012. Currently at Turrill, classrooms are being modified with air conditioning units, space is being created for a larger media center to support the size of the school, and space is being created to assist in supporting all students. ## Intersessions

Turrill intersessions will consist of three weeks during the school year where students will not be in school unless families choose to pay the intersession fee and send their students. These intersessions will be an opportunity for students to participate in a theme-based week, with teachers participating in various activities. Each day, all of the activities will revolve around the theme of the week that may include, but is not limited to; field trips, assemblies, arts and crafts, research, reading, writing, and technology. If families are interested in the intersession, they will sign up in advance and submit the payment to the office. As we begin to plan for our intersession, please begin to discuss with family members if your child will be attending the intersession's the weeks of October 29 through November 2, February 25 through March 1, and May 6 through May 10. Shortly after the start of the year the intersession coordinator will be sending home some information on the themes we will be using as well as a survey to gauge interest in the intersessions.

## Links Program

Turrill, like many other LCS schools as well as schools across the state, will continue their LINKS program for the 2012 – 2013 school year. The purpose of the LINKS program is to offer peer to peer support programs to provide increased opportunity for all students. Peers called “LINKS” model typical academic and social behavior in educational environments throughout the school day and thus provide support for students to promote independence and socialization.

The LINK program addresses the effort mandated by the Michigan Department of Education, Office of Special Education and Early Intervention Services (MDE OSE-EIS) to reduce the number of special education eligible students in separate learning environments. LINK support allows students with ASD to have more regular access to general education environments and curriculum through peer modeling and mentoring, which leads to greater academic and social success across their school day.

In addition to supporting students with ASD, the LINKS program also supports all students. The increased modeling of typical academic and social behavior in schools increases our focus on positive behaviors, which supports the entire school community. Please look for information regarding the LINKS program in early August.
